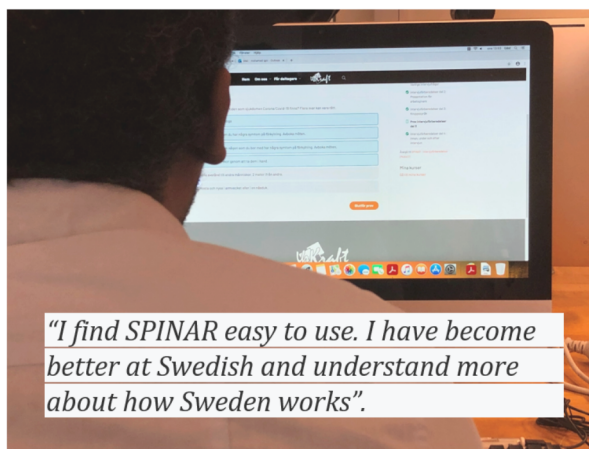
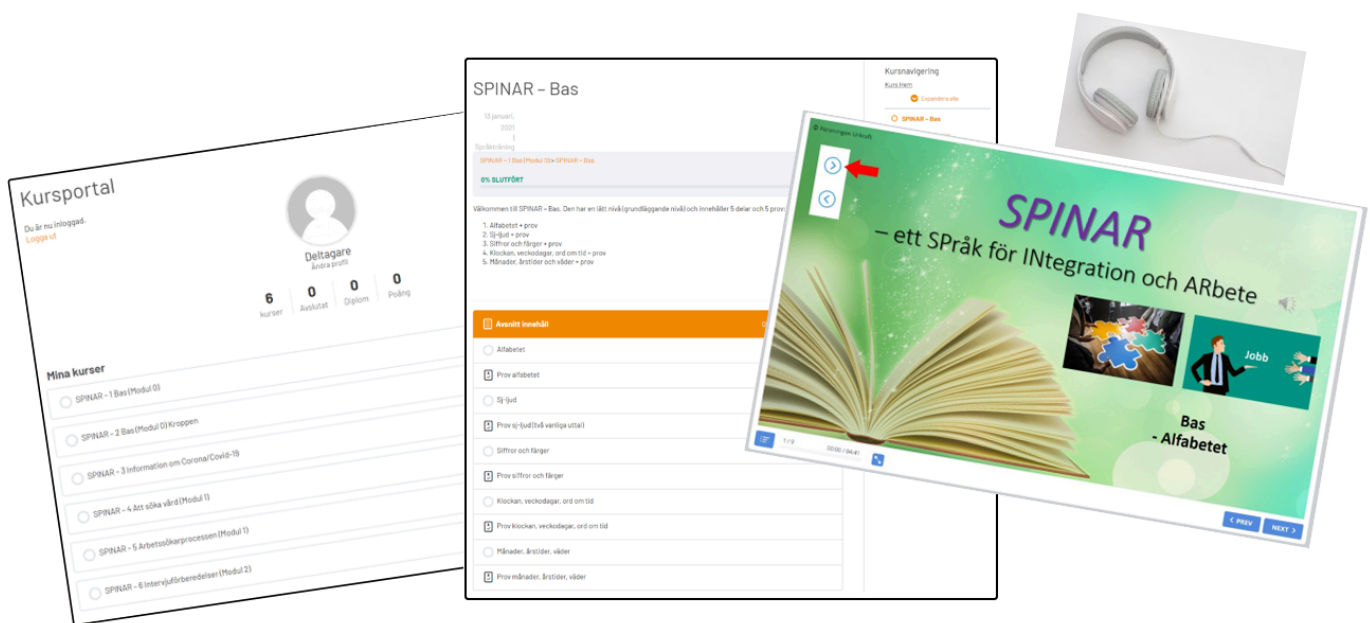




PRODUCT SHEET FOR SPINAR

Digital language tool to learn Swedish and give you knowledge about Sweden with the help of text, images and sound.

There are several courses in SPINAR at different levels of difficulty. On the next page you can see both the course content and the level of difficulty of the courses. Green means easy and red means hard.

Course 1: SPINAR – Base (Module 0).

Basic basic knowledge. Contains 5 lessons and 5 tests. Difficulty: Easy.



- The alphabet + Test
- Sj sound + Test
- Numbers and colors + Test
- The time, days of the week, words about time + Test
- Months, seasons and weather + Test

Course 2: SPINAR – Base (Module 0) The body.

Basic knowledge of body part names. Contains 3 lessons and 3 tests. Difficulty: Easy.



- Front of the body + Test
- Face, mouth, hand, foot + Test
- The back of the body + Test
- Closing part

Course 3: SPINAR – Information about Corona/Covid-19.

1 lesson and 1 test. Difficulty: Easy - medium.



- Information about Corona/Covid-19 + Test

Course 4: SPINAR – Seeking healthcare (Module 1).

Community information. Words you need to know and information you need to know when seeking healthcare. Contains 4 lessons or parts and 4 tests. Difficulty: Easy - medium.



- Part 1: Physical and mental problems + Test
- Part 2: Common words and different professions in healthcare + Test
- Part 3: Common words + Tests
- Part 4: Seeking healthcare and what to do if your life or that of others is in danger + Test
- Closing part

Course 5: SPINAR – The job seeker process (Module 1).

Words and information that you need to know when looking for a job. Contains 12 lessons, 12 tests and a large final assignment containing 8 parts. You must first pass all exams in the course before you can do the final task. It is about creating your CV and cover letter. Difficulty: Easy at the beginning then it becomes medium and at the end it becomes hard. This is the largest course. Below you see examples of what the lessons or parts are about.



- Part 1: Different words for jobs, common words in a workplace, what a company can look like + Test
- Part 2: Work experience, internship, words about time, working hours, form of employment, vacation + Test
- Part 3: Time off, private life, free time, leisure interests, hobby, different words for friend + Test
- Part 4: Characteristics, strong points, developable points, stress-resistant, stress-sensitive + Test
- Part 5: School/education, grades, degree, theoretical and practical knowledge, competence, certificate + Test
- Part 6: Industries + Test
- Part 7: Common difficult words in job advertisements, the Place bank, extracts from the load register + Test
- Part 8: CV and personal letter, references, certificates and grades + Test
- Part 9: Application, application documents, employment contract, finance and budget, salary + Test
- Part 10: Networks, hidden jobs, what to think about before, during and after an interview + Test
- Part 11: Recruitment process, staffing agency + Test
- Part 12: Collective agreement, The Union, unemployment insurance + Test
- Final task containing 8 parts (8 tasks)

Course 6: SPINAR – Interview preparation (Module 2).

Words and information that you need to know when going to a job interview. 4 lessons, 1 exam and 3 assignments. Difficulty: Difficult, except for part 3 which is easy.



- Part 1: Common interview questions + Task/exercise
- Part 2: Presentation for employers + Task/exercise
- Part 3: Body language + Task/exercise + Test
- Part 4: Before, during and after the interview + Task

SPINAR is easiest to use with a computer but also works well with an iPad or iPhone. If you have an Android device, you need to download an app. You need an email address to get a user in the course portal. You will receive a username and password from your supervisor at Urkraft.
